Artificial Intelligence Study Plan







- to your study plan








Lecturers

- You will then have access to the didactic material that the teacher will make available there









Important Reminders

- request your Italian tax code;
- request your residence permit and send it through filodiretto;
- submit your study plan (according to the deadlines of your degree program)
- submit to the Admission Office the documents requested to finalize your enrollment - if still missing (deadline December 1st 2025);
- pay the second installment of the tuition fees (deadline December 11th 2025).



Services & Facilities

Please note all the following services & facilities are referred to the University of Pavia, please check in UniMi and UniMib websites for the facilities they offer!



Part-time collaborations and tutoring

Part-time collaborations: students collaborate with the University engaging in activities aimed at improving services for students.

Workload: ranging from 50 to 150 hours per year.

Compensation: flat rate of € 7.75 net per hour, exempt from taxes, for each hour worked.

Tutoring: supporting students during their academic life, from the moment they enter the university until graduation. As a tutor you will collaborate to refine the available resources and help students to face the possible difficulties during different phases of their training process.

Applications are open twice a year: once in September and once in May.

Compensation: about €14/hour.


